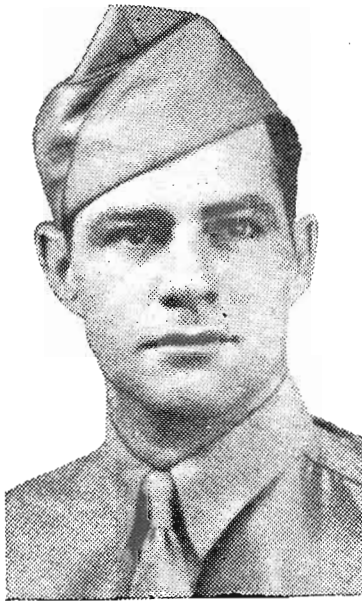




**RICHARD J. ROMERO**
