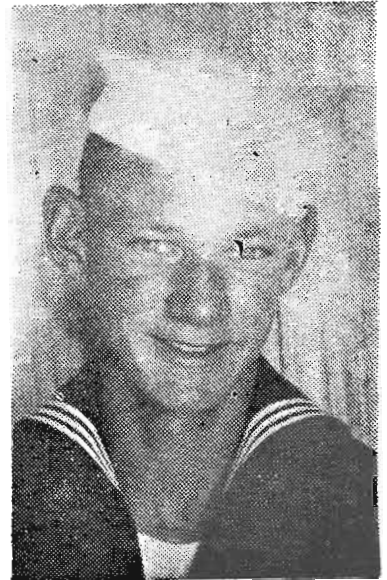
In the service for approximately 20 months, Hebert was formerly with the Seabees before being transferred to the Navy.
