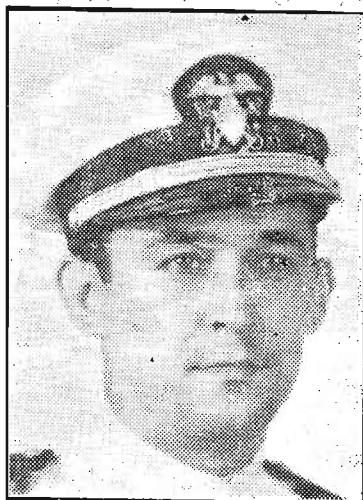


RAYMOND HEBERT

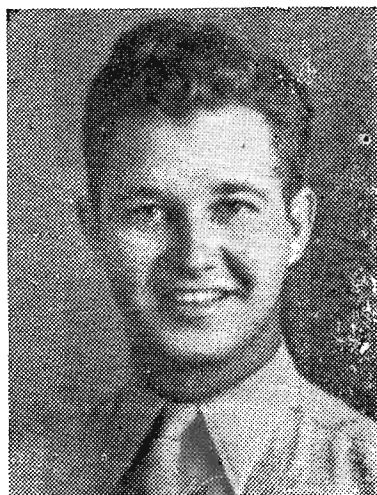
WILBUR L. ALLAIN
