



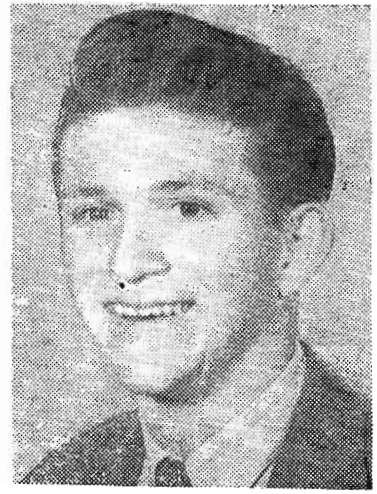
DANIEL L. VERRET

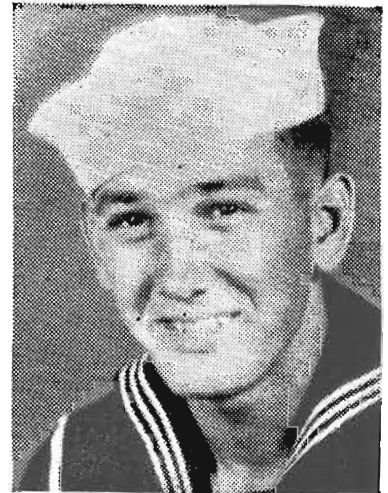


NATHAN SIMONEAUX
