



N. J. ROCCAFORTE

Lt. (j. g.) N. J. Roccaforte, son of Mr. and Mrs. B. N. Roccaforte of Houston, Texas and grandson of Mrs. Sam Mannina of Jeanerette who was reported missing on a bomber raid over Clark Field in the Phillippines on October 29, 1944 and later killed in a crash on January 15, 1945 while being evacuated from the front area. The Lieutenant, a torpedo plane pilot, had been overseas one year. Prior to his flying service, he was in the Navy four years, attending the University of Hawaii.



RIPLEY G. JUDICE

Cpl Ripley G. Judice, son of Mr. and Mrs. D. P. Judice, Jeanerette, has been in the service approximately twenty-one months. Overseas for seven months, Judice saw action in the Marshalls and Saipan where he was wounded and was awarded the Purple Heart.
