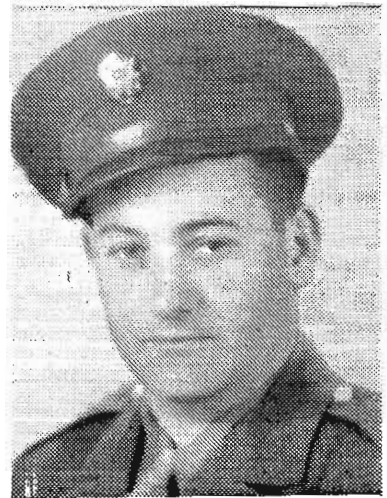
JULIUS J. BOUTTE
