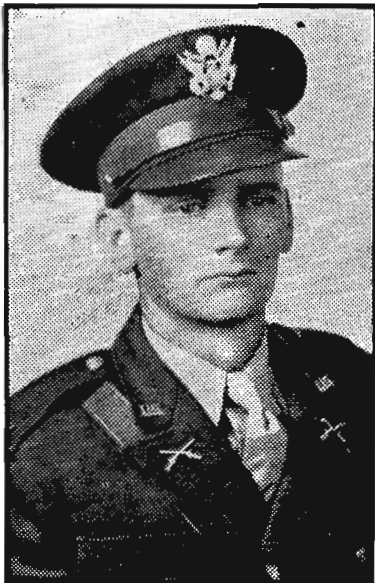


LAWRENCE J. BOREL
